What is Love to Ride?

Love To Ride is a free online platform for logging bike rides and encouraging biking through online community connections, goal-setting, and friendly competition using leaderboards and challenges. Riders of all abilities, ages 13 and up, log their bike trips using the Love to Ride app, by syncing with fitness apps Strava or Map My Ride, or by entering their trip information manually. Riders may be eligible for prizes and awards offered by the Love to Ride platform.

Love to Ride hosts a number of challenges throughout the year including the Bike Month Challenge in May, Cycle September, and Winter Wheelers. Riders may join groups/clubs, ride with their registered Workplace, or participate as a solo rider.
