

## Simsbury to Hartford by Bike & Bus (Tariffville, too!)

CTtransit Express buses link Simsbury and other Farmington Valley towns with West Hartford and downtown Hartford. Did you know you can bike to a CTtransit bus stop, then put your bike on the bus? Many of the commuter lots have bike racks, too, if you'd rather park your bike for the day. Simsbury has bus stops in the commuter lots right the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail greenway in Weatogue (Winslow Place) and on Iron Horse Blvd. Residents in the south



of town may find bus stops along Rte. 44 more convenient, and Tariffville residents now have an easy 3.5-mile bike route to the **Local** bus stops on Griffin Rd. South in Bloomfield and Griffin Rd. North in Windsor via the Tariffville-Bloomfield Greenway.

## **CTtransit Bus Routes**

- The Simsbury-Granby Express Bus #912 services Simsbury along the Rt. 10/Hopmeadow St. corridor with five stops and three park & ride lots. From Simsbury you can take this bus to Hartford (7 stops), West Hartford (2 stops), and Granby (4 stops).
- The Avon-Canton (#901), Winsted (#926) and Torrington (#927) Express Buses follow the Rt. 44 Albany Turnpike corridor with Simsbury stops at Staples /McDonald's. There are also stops near the center of Avon. From Simsbury you can take these buses to Hartford (6 stops), West Hartford (3 stops), Torrington and several communities in between.
- Local CTtransit buses Blue Hills Ave., #54 and Windsor Ave-Day Hill Rd. #36 service Griffin Rd. South (Bloomfield) and Griffin Rd. North (Windsor) with stops less than 1 mile from the Bloomfield-Tariffville Greenway on Day Hill Rd. in Bloomfield. You can take these buses to destinations in Windsor, Bloomfield and Hartford.
